To explore what is meant by these skills, including critical thinking, problem solving, creativity and learning to learn (ways of thinking); communicating and collaborating (ways of working); information literacy and ICT literacy (tools for working) and their increasing importance in education globally.

To consider how we can incorporate ways of thinking, ways of working and tools for working in our teaching and learning and how these skills are embedded in the CEFR and Cambridge English exams.
